## Youth Recognition Programs

The Young Achievers and Leaders of Tomorrow Programs encourage student leaders by recognizing and applauding positive achievement, behavior, leadership and service. Young Achievers are students in grades 5-10, and Leaders of Tomorrow are students in grade 11 who are:

- **Successful achievers in a variety of areas**
- **Leaders who are appointed and/or elected**
- **Positive role models**
- **Good citizens in their schools and communities**
- **Competent scholars with good attendance records**

Young Achievers and Leaders of Tomorrow receive International Leadership Network Certificates and are considered for the following special awards:

**2 Young Achievers of the Year (1 in grades 5-7; 1 in grades 8-10)**  
**Leader of the Year (grade 11)**

These special award recipients each receive an award and \$500. In addition, the Leader of the Year receives registration and expenses to attend a Leadership Conference.

A student may be recognized as a Young Achiever 2 times with 2 years between recognitions.

Young Achiever Nominations must be postmarked by May 15 for consideration that year.  
(Nominations postmarked after May 15 will be held for the following year.)

Leaders of Tomorrow Nominations must be postmarked by June 15 for consideration that year.  
(Nominations postmarked after June 15 will be held for the following year.)

### Required Information

A letter from the nominator and the following information, in the form of a student resume, **MUST** accompany the signed nomination form. List, describe and give years for the following. Include information for the past three years.

- **Recognition/awards received for outstanding achievement**
- **Leadership roles (elected/appointed)**
- **School participation (classroom/extracurricular)**
- **Volunteer service (community, youth and faith-based organizations)**
- **Employment (if any)**
